III. DESCRIPTION

A. Background

As part of the MI-5 alignment project. The SRJB has agreed to relocate a 60 x 200 foot building that was acquired out to the Public Works facility for use in storing flood control closures and flood control related equipment.

B. Proposed Project

The project moves a 60' x 200' building from 13th street NE and Railway to the Public Works Yard for storage of flood control equipment and closure pieces so that there is a central location for this equipment.

C. Consultant Selection

Houston Engineering, Barr – Ackerman along with and HDR Engineers were selected by the SRJB in accordance with state statute to design phases of the MREFPP.
