**SUBJECT: ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSE RENEWALS**

**I. RECOMMENDED ACTION**

1. It is recommended the City Council approve the alcoholic beverage license renewals for the period of January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022 for the following businesses:
  - a. Loyal order of Moose dba Moose Lodge No. 822 at 400 9<sup>th</sup> Street SW
  - b. Minot State Beaver Boosters dba Minot State University at 500 University Ave W
  - c. Thai Hot dba Thai Hot at 101 Central Ave W
  - d. El Azteca LLC dba El Azteca at 2035 N Broadway
  - e. Urban Gourmet, LLC The Station at 1303 S Broadway
  - f. The Putt District LLC dba The Putt District at 17 South Main Street
  - g. 21 EC Ventures LLC dba Iron Horse Kitchen and Bar at 21 E Central Ave # 101

**III. DESCRIPTION**

Background

In order to renew an alcoholic beverage license, an application must be submitted for review by the Police Department and inspections are done by the Building Official and Fire Marshal. Complete renewal applications approved by the Police Chief.

The fees vary depending on the type of license and is deposited into the appropriate general fund revenue account.

**V. ALTERNATIVES**

The City Council could deny a license renewal application if there is reasonable cause to do so, and the establishment would not be permitted to sell alcohol until obtaining a local alcoholic beverage license.

**VI. TIME CONSTRAINTS**

Current licenses expire at 11:59 pm on December 31st of this year. If the establishment is continuing the sale of alcohol, the license renewal needs to be approved by City Council prior to that time.
