Lindbo or Golden Touch Specialties is the lowest bidder based on the depth identified in the RFQ of a 6" event. However, there are exceptions to the bid. We required that the snow be cleared within 48 hours after the storm ends. He states in his bid he could not start until 48-72 hours after the event as his company is fully booked for first day commercial services for snow removal. He further goes on to state his hourly rate for snow removal and snow blowing etc. are as well as he does not have a specific amount of hours for each location, when in fact we did not ask for hourly rates or specific hours for each location, rather for a lump sum price for clearing all of the areas based on a certain depth of snow event. He also did not include a cost for just an ice event to treat that, instead he just said included, which does not make much sense. Finally, if you look at the bid amount for a 1-4" event, his bid is \$5, I can only guess that this is an error as the other events bid were in the thousands of dollars range, so it appears that this should have been \$5000 not \$5 dollars. Therefore, with the exceptions noted and the error in the bid amount, I would suggest this bid not be considered.
