I. RECOMMENDED ACTION

It is recommended the City Council approve the Supper Club license for Nickels and Dimes, Inc dba Tilt Studio operating at 2400 10th St SW Building E, Minot.

III. DESCRIPTION

The City received a request from Nickels and Dimes, Inc, for a Supper Club license operating at 2400 10th St SW Building E. All documentation has been submitted and inspections relating to the proposed premises have been approved by the Police Chief, Building Official and Fire Marshal.

Fiscal Impact:

Alcoholic beverage license applications are processed by the City Clerk. The application fee for a Supper Club license is \$3,125.00 annually and is deposited into the appropriate general fund revenue account.

V. CITY COUNCIL ASPIRATIONS

The Safe & Welcoming aspiration aligns with this process by making sure each license holder follows all the City of Minot ordinances pertaining to alcohol licensing.

VI. ALTERNATIVES

The City Council could deny this application if there is reasonable cause to do so and the establishment would not be permitted to sell alcohol.

VII. TIME CONSTRAINTS

Once the City license is approved, the organization must also apply for a State license. A timely approval is necessary if their business wishes to proceed with the sale of alcohol.
