

Invitation to apply for the Board of Directors and the Executive Director for the Minot Area Recovery Communities Organization.

A recovery community organization is an independent nonprofit organization led and governed by the representatives of local communities of recovery. These organizations organize recovery focused policy advocacy activities, carry out recovery focused community education and outreach programs, and/or provide peer-based recovery support services. The broadly defined recovery community people in long-term recovery their families/friends and allies including recovery focused addiction and recovery professionals includes organizations whose members reflect religious spiritual and secular pathways of recovery. The sole mission of the Recovery Community Organization is to mobilize resources within and outside of the recovery community to increase the prevalence and quality of long-term recovery from alcohol and other drug addictions. Public education policy advocacy and peer-based recovery support services are the strategies through which this mission is achieved.

The local board of directors will be made up of six individuals of which, 50% or more have to be individuals in long-term recovery. Individuals will also will not be employees of local recovery communities, including areas within 100 mile radius of Minot. Once the Board of Directors is selected their first order of business will be the selection of an Executive Director.

The Board of Directors and the Executive Director will be responsible for the administering of the Bush Grant received by the Minot Area Committee on Addiction.
