THE CITY OF MINOT ACTION PLAN AMENDMENT #2

Through this Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Disaster Recovery (DR) Amendment #2, the City will be deleting two of its original proposed activities, and reducing funds for a third activity identified in the approved Action Plan. The reduced funds will be used to create a new activity. Full descriptions of proposed changes for Amendment #2 are described in the following paragraphs.

The Downtown Infrastructure project is being removed as this will now be funded through other sources. The CDBG-DR funds are being appropriated to assist the parking garages which support the Imagine Minot Affordable Rental Project. These changes are reflected in Table 1 below.

The Voluntary Acquisition of Flood Properties Project will have funds reallocated to a new and separate Demolition of Flooded Properties Activity. This new activity will address the need to clear properties purchased under the Voluntary Acquisition of Flooded Properties Program. These changes are reflected in Table 1 below.

The CDM Smith Project Delivery Activity is being removed as a standalone activity and reallocated accordingly to each of the specific activities. These changes will be described in Table 2 (attached).

The following activities are proposed to be removed or reduced:

- Affordable Rental Housing/ **Infrastructure Repairs Downtown**
- Housing/ **Acquisition of Flooded Properties**
- Project Delivery/ **CDM Smith**

The following project is proposed to be increased:

- Affordable Rental Housing/ **“Imagine Minot” Downtown Development Parking Facility.**

The following project is proposed to be added to the Action Plan:

- Housing/ **Demolition of Flooded Properties**
