

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

CITY OF MINOT, NORTH DAKOTA 6TH STREET UNDERPASS STORM WATER PUMP STATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Minot, North Dakota will receive separate sealed Bids for the mechanical, electrical, general and combined prime construction of the 6th Street Underpass Storm Water Pump Station, at the office of the City Clerk, 515 Second Avenue SW (Second Floor), until 11:00 AM on Friday, May 28th, 2013, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read in the Council Chambers.

All Bids must be submitted, and all work shall be done, in full and strict compliance with the Plans and Specifications for this project.

Generally, the Work covered by the Plans and Specifications for the 6th Street Underpass Storm Water Pump Station is the material, labor, tools and equipment required for the construction of a 33 foot by 39 foot storm water pump station with an approximate depth of 35 feet. The pump station includes an above grade structure and three submersible pumps with a combined horsepower of approximately 1000 hp. Details of the construction are included in the Drawings and Project Manual.

All Bids are to be submitted on the basis of cash payment for the Work and Materials, and are to be enclosed in a sealed envelope addressed to the undersigned City Clerk, accompanied by a separate envelope containing a Bidder's Bond in the sum equal to 5% of the full amount of the Bid, executed by the Bidder as Principal, and by a Surety, conditioned that if the Principal's Bid is accepted and the contract awarded to the Principal, the Principal, within ten days after notice of award, shall execute a Contract in accordance with the terms of the Bid and Performance and Payment Bonds as required by the law and the regulation and determinations of the Owner. Countersignature of a Bid Bond is not required. Bidders shall be licensed for the full amount of the Bid, as required by Section 43-07-05 of the North Dakota Century Code.

Attention is called to the fact that compliance with Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) is required on this project and will include Davis Bacon labor rates, Section 3 employment plan, not less than the minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid on this project, and that the Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex, or national origin.

No Bid may be read or considered if it does not fully comply with the requirements of Section 48-01.1-05 of the North Dakota Century Code. Any deficient Bid received will be resealed and returned to the Bidder immediately.

The City Council reserves the right to hold all Bids for 30 days, to reject any or all Bids and to waive any informality or irregularity in any Bid and to accept the Bid deemed in the best interest of the Owner.

There shall be endorsed upon the outside of the envelope containing the Bid, the following:

1. "City of Minot, North Dakota, 6th Street Underpass Storm Water Pump Station."
2. The name of the person, firm, corporation, or joint venture submitting the Bid.
3. The Bidder's Contractor's License or Contractor's License Renewal Number. A copy of the Bidder's Contractor's License shall be included in the Bid Bond envelope along with the bid.

4. Acknowledgement of the Addenda.

All site work shall be substantially complete by November 1, 2013. Structural, architectural, mechanical and electrical work shall be substantially complete by May 15, 2014. All work shall be completed and ready for final payment in accordance with the General Conditions by June 15, 2014.

Should the Contractor fail to complete its obligations under the Contract within the time required herein or within such extra time as may have been granted by formal extensions of time approved by the Owner, there will be deducted from any amount due to the Contractor the sum of \$1,000 per day for each and every calendar day that the completion of the Work is delayed. The Contractor and his Surety will be liable for any excess. Such payment will be as and for liquidated damages and not as a penalty.
